Principal responsibilities

Pre-event

- Assisting with drinks and bar kit packing

Events

- Managing the bar unit transportation and set up when required
- Manage event daytime drinks service and bar service
- Managing and maintaining stock levels and glassware
- Working closely with the Lead Chef, Event Manager and Front of House Team in a professional manner to deliver high quality customer service
- Assisting in the set-up of dinner tables and food stations, as well as food service when required
- Unpacking the kit into the warehouse post event
- Ensuring a clean and sanitised bar environment at all times
